# More spaces at Asquith

A 42-space commuter car-park at Asquith train station is on the way with work expected to start at Jersey St North within a few months and be finished by the first half of 2017.

Hornsby state Liberal MP Matt Kean said improved station facilities would include two accessible parking spaces close to the station (within the Haldane St car-

park), a pedestrian link from the carpark to the station, improved lighting and CCTV surveillance.

"Our focus is to deliver this much-needed project as quickly as possible for customers," Mr Kean said.

"Now that a contractor is on board, detailed design will get under way so we can continue to progress our plans.

"This new carpark at Asquith Station will make catching public transport a much more attractive option for customers."

Transport for NSW warned the work may be noisy at times.

"Every effort will be made to minimise disruption to nearby residents and customers," a spokesman said.
