NEW 'NO PARKING ZONES' FOR HORNSBY

In an effort to improve traffic flow, new 'no parking' zones have been installed on Peats Ferry Road in the very busy section between Bridge and Galston Roads.

Hornsby State MP Matt Kean said, "Introducing 'no parking zones' to Peats Ferry Road between Bridge Road and the Galston Road intersection will reduce congestion for motorists and improve journey times.'



Motorists are now provided with two travel lanes in the peak direction which will improve traffic flow.

The new zones apply on weekdays between 6am and 10am along the east side of Peats Ferry Road between Galston Road and Bridge Road.

Zones will also be in place on weekdays between 3pm and 7pm along the west side of Peats Ferry Road between Bridge Road and Galston Road.

"Traffic lights were installed at the intersection Peats Ferry Road, Watson Avenue and Mildred Avenue last year to allow for future traffic growth and provide safe access to Mt Wilga Hospital," said Mr Kean. Mr Kean said the new 'no parking zones' were installed after consultation with the community earlier this year.
